# **Subject-Based Banding (Primary)**

- Subject-based Banding (Primary) offers students the option of taking the 4 core subjects at either the Standard or Foundation level, depending on their strengths. This will allow students to focus on and stretch their potential in the subjects they are strong in while building up the fundamentals in the subject they need more support in.
- Schools will continue to recommend based on the following:
   Student's aptitude, motivation and performance in each subject; and
   Student's ability to cope with a particular subject combination

### **Considerations for recommendation of P5 Subject Combination**

### 1. P4 results

- 2. Minimum required marks met at P4
- 3. Past year performances of the student's subject (P1-P3 results)

# **The PSLE Score**

 The ALs for the four subjects, i.e., English Language, Mother Tongue Languages, Mathematics and Science will be added to form the PSLE score.

The PSLE score will be used for students' Secondary One course placement and school posting.

## WHAT ARE Als?

- AL stands for Achievement Level (AL).
- Students with similar scores in each subject are grouped into scoring bands measured in 8 ALs.

 AL A to AL C for Foundation level subjects are mapped to AL 6 to AL 8 of Standard level subjects respectively, to derive a student's overall PSLE Score.

- PSLE Scores range from 4 to 32, with 4 being the best.
- You will be placed in a secondary school through one of three posting groups based on your PSLE Score – Posting Group 1, Posting Group 2 or Posting
   Group 3.
- Posting groups will not limit your secondary school experience or post-secondary options.
