3. Chinese New Year Celebration and Chinese New Year Holidays

Our school's Chinese New Year celebration will be held on 09 February Friday from 7.30a.m. to 10.30a.m. Students should report straight to their classrooms in their CNY traditional costumes or P.E. attire with white school shoes. They can bring a small bag, water-bottle, pencil-case, colour pencils and snacks. The canteen will be closed on that day. There will be CNY classroom activities for students followed by a concert in the school hall. Students will be dismissed at 10.30am and the school will be closed soon after. School will be closed on 12 and 13 February for the Chinese New Year holidays and resume on 14 February Wednesday.

4. Total Defence Day 2024 TD40: 40 Years of Total Defence – Together We Keep Singapore Strong

Schools commemorate Total Defence Day (TDD) on 15 February each year to mark the fall of Singapore to the Japanese in 1942. This year marks the 40th year of Total Defence (TD40) in Singapore with the theme "Together We Keep Singapore Strong". The focus for TD40 will be on Singaporean's readiness and resilience in the face of crises and disruptions. Every Singaporean plays a part in our daily lives to ensure that Singapore is prepared for crises and disruptions. As part of the commemoration of TD40, schools will conduct a TD40 Exercise for students to experience simulations of possible disruptions to Singapore.

AIPS will be commemorating TD40 on 15 February Thursday with two simulated disruptions and recess fringe activities. TDD classroom activities will be conducted on 16 February Friday and a TDD-related assembly programme will be held on 20 February Tuesday.
