Dear Parents / Guardians (Our Valued Partners-in-Education),

Here are some updates for March 2024.

1. School Attire/ Name Tags

The school has communicated with the students that they are required to be in their full school uniform / PE attire as long as they are in school (including after school hours and school holidays). Students are to wear their name tags on their school uniform. For boys, the name tags are to be placed on the upper edge of the pocket. For girls, the name tags are to be placed below the school crest. As for PE attire, the name tags should be placed below the school crest. Please refer to page 11 of the Students' Handbook 2024 for the visuals. A school attire check will be conducted at the end of March. If you have not made name tags for your child, please obtain a form from the Class Mentor to place the order as soon as possible. The lead time for the delivery of name tags is one to two months.

2. Primary 6 Weighted Assessments

We would like to remind parents of the school's assessment guidelines:

- There will be no make-up papers for students who are absent during the conduct of Weighted Assessments.
- Students who are on medical leave are required to produce medical certificates immediately upon return to school. His/her marks will be computed accordingly. No marks will be awarded for the subject if no medical certificate is produced.
- Students who are unwell are advised to visit a doctor, rest at home and not to sit for their Weighted Assessments.
