## Dear Parents / Guardians (Our Valued Partners-in-Education)

Here are some updates for May and June 2026.

### 1. Weighted Assessments (WA) for Primary 3 to 6 levels

Primary 3 to 6 students will be sitting for the Term 2 Weighted Assessments on the dates stated below:

We would like to remind you of the school's **Assessment Rules and Regulations**:

- The well-being of our students is of utmost importance. We appeal to parents not to send your child to school to sit for the assessments if he/she is unwell/on medical leave (i.e. with a medical certificate).
- Students are required to submit their medical certificates to their Class Mentors immediately upon return to school.
- There will be no make-up assessments for students who are absent on written Weighted Assessment/Examination days even if he/she has a medical certificate.
- No marks will be awarded to the student if he/she is absent from any assessment without a valid medical certificate.

The following table indicates the various actions by the school for students who are absent for any assessments:

Reasons for Absence	Action by School
Absent without a valid reason	No marks will be awarded for the assessments not sat for
Absent with a Medical Certificate	Component(s)/paper(s) not sat for will not be used for the computation of the Overall Subject Results

- Students will not be allowed to take the assessment if they are
  - late for more than 15 mins for papers with duration of 1 hour or less, *OR*
  - late for more than 30 mins for papers with duration of more than 1 hour.
- Students who are late will not be given extra time to complete the assessment.
- As part of the school's efforts to support and monitor students' learning, absentees will be given a copy of the papers they did not sit for **as a practice** after they have recovered and returned to school.

## 2. Briefing on Refreshed Approach to Supporting Students with Academic Strength and Talents for Primary 3 Parents on Tuesday, 12 May

The briefing on the Refreshed Approach to Supporting Students with Academic Strength and Talents will be held online on Tuesday, 12 May from 4pm to 5pm. Details of the briefing will be shared via Parent Gateway.

## 3. Parent-Child-Teacher Conference/Parent-Teacher Conference on Thursday and Friday, 28 and 29 May

The P1 and P2 Parent-Child-Teacher Conference (PCTC) and P3-6 Parent-Teacher Conference (PTC) will be held on Thursday, 28 May and Friday, 29 May 2026. This provides a platform for students to share their learning with teachers and parents, and teachers to share holistic feedback for parents' partnership.

All students should not report to school on both days. They should complete their June school holiday homework at home.

Parents will be invited to discuss your child's / ward's progress and development with their Class Mentors (CMs) on Thursday, 28 May and Subject Teachers on Friday, 29 May. Some parents may also receive the feedback via a phone call from CMs from Monday, 18 May.

P3 to P6	<b>Online PTC via MS Teams (selected parents)</b> Students need not be present for the PTC session.

All appointment bookings with Class Mentors will open from Friday, 15 May 2026 (9am) and will close on Thursday, 21 May 2026 (5pm).

### P3 – P6

All appointment bookings with Subject Teachers will open from Monday, 18 May 2026 (9am) and will close on Friday, 22 May 2026 (5pm).

CMs and Subject Teachers will send selected parents a letter on Parents Gateway for the appointment bookings. Appointments are booked on a first-come-first-served basis.

## 4. P6 Power Up Sessions from Wednesday, 24 June to Friday, 26 June

To support our graduating students in their journey towards PSLE, our school has planned Power Up Sessions for P6 students from Wednesday, 24 June to Friday, 26 June, 8.00am to 1.00pm. The Power Up Sessions are aimed at providing focused and intensive support to ensure that your child / ward is well-prepared for the upcoming PSLE.

Please note that your child's / ward's attendance at the Power Up Sessions is compulsory. We sincerely seek your support in ensuring their participation, as their active involvement will greatly contribute to their academic development and overall success in the PSLE.
