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## Dear Parents / Guardians (Our Valued Partners-in-Education)

We want to welcome all students back to school this week. Here are some updates for the month of July 2023.

### 1. Youth Day (02 July, Sunday)

Youth Day falls on 02 July, Sunday and 03 July, Monday is a scheduled school holiday. All students will report back to school on 04 July, Tuesday.

The General Office will also be closed on Youth Day as the office staff will be attending an external learning event.

### 2. Racial Harmony Day Commemoration (21 July, Friday)

We will be commemorating Racial Harmony Day on this day. This year's Racial Harmony Day theme, 'Singapore: Our Multicultural Mosaic', focuses on the appreciation of the diverse races and religions that make up our multicultural society, and contribute to our shared sense of cohesion and harmony. Our students will participate in an assembly programme and recess fringe activities to help them apply the theme in their lives, to explore what it means to strengthen connection amongst communities, and to take action to preserve racial harmony in Singapore.

### 3. School Emergency Preparedness Exercise (July)

We wish to inform you that our School will be conducting the second emergency preparedness exercise some time in Jul-Aug period. The students will not know the date in advance this round. As part of the SGSecure framework to safeguard Singapore and our way of life, this exercise aims to ensure the safety and well-being of all students and staff by preparing them to respond to emergencies in the school premises and be familiar with the safety and evacuation procedures.

SGSecure is a movement to build the resilience of our community and aims to sensitise, train and mobilise the community during emergencies. SGSecure focuses on **three** core actions [Staying Alert (Vigilance), Staying United (Cohesion), Staying Strong (Resilience)] that every one of us can do during emergencies.

The well-being of all students and staff is important to us. We seek your understanding and support for the upcoming emergency preparedness exercise.

### 4. P6 Prelim EL and MTL Oral Exams (02 August, Wednesday and 03 August, Thursday)

The P6 Prelim English and Mother Tongue Languages Oral Examinations will be conducted on 02 August, Wednesday, and 03 August, Thursday, from 2pm to 5pm. Students will be dismissed from school once they have completed their oral examination for the day. For P6 students taking NTIL, foreign language in-lieu of Mother Tongue Language or are exempted from MTL, they will only need to stay back in school on the day of their English or Foundation English oral examination.
