Dear Parents / Guardians (Our Valued Partners-in-Education)

Here are some updates for October 2023.

1. Children's Day Celebration and Children's Day School Holiday

The school will be celebrating Children's Day on 05 October, Thursday. Students will report to school as usual on that day. The dismissal time will be at 10.30am. They are to wear their school PE attire and school shoes and may bring along a snack to consume during their snack break. The school will be closed on 06 October, Friday for Children's Day school holiday.

As part of the celebration, during recesses on 09 October, Monday, in addition to the usual items, the school canteen vendors will be selling some special snacks and food items such as chicken burger, potato fries, fruit jelly on an exceptional basis. These are some of the food items the students have expressed that they would like to have. The prices will range from \$0.30 to \$2.30. We thank the canteen vendors who put in the extra efforts to cheer our students on this special occasion.

2. 2023 PSLE Marking Exercise

The 2023 PSLE Marking Exercise will be held on 16 October, Monday to 18 October, Wednesday. Students are not required to report to school on those days and will stay at home to revise for their upcoming semestral assessment, as well as spend quality interaction time with you. School will resume on 19 October, Thursday for all students.

3. End-of-Year Examinations (EYE)

We would like to inform parents of the school's assessment guidelines:

- There will be no make-up papers for students who are absent on Written Paper (including Listening Comprehension) examination days.
- Students who are on medical leave are required to produce medical certificates (MC) immediately upon return to school. His/her marks will be computed accordingly. No marks will be awarded for the subject if no medical certificate is produced.
- Students who are tested positive for COVID-19 and absent from Written Paper (including Listening Comprehension) examination would not be required to produce MC, doctor's letter or recovery memo to cover their absence. However, Class Mentors (CMs) are to have sight of the photo evidence of the positive ART result.
- Students who are unwell are advised to rest at home and not sit for their Written Paper examination.
- Students who arrive 30 minutes or later after the examination paper has started will not be allowed to sit for the paper. No marks will be awarded for that paper.
- Year-end oral examinations will be conducted after school. Students will be dismissed from school once they have completed their oral examination for the day. Please make necessary transport arrangements for your child/ward.
- On the designated oral examination days for the level, your child/ward will be sitting for either his/her English or Mother Tongue Language Oral Examination on the first day and the other language oral examination on the second day.
- Should your child/ward be absent on their oral examination day, a make-up oral examination will be conducted for them on 20 October, Friday during curriculum time.
