Dear Parents / Guardians (Our Valued Partners-in-Education)

Here are some updates for May and June 2023.

1. Weighted Assessment (WA) for Primary 3 to 6

We would like to remind parents of the school's guidelines:

- There will be no make-up papers for students who are absent on Weighted Assessment days.
- Students who are on medical leave are required to produce medical certificates (MC) immediately upon return to school. His/her marks will be computed accordingly. No marks will be awarded for the subject if no medical certificate is produced.
- Students who are tested positive for COVID-19 and absent from Weighted Assessment would not be required
 to produce MC, doctor's letter or recovery memo to cover their absence. However, Class Mentors (CMs) are
 to have sight of the affected student's photo evidence of the positive ART result.
- Students who are unwell are advised to rest at home and not sit for their Weighted Assessment.
- Students who arrive 30 minutes or later after the examination paper has started will not be allowed to sit for the paper. No marks will be awarded for that paper.
- In the case of major disruptions (e.g. due to major train service disruption, flooding, massive traffic jam), students are allowed to sit for the examinations, and will be given the full paper duration.

2. School Emergency Preparedness Exercise on Tuesday, 16 May

SGSecure is a movement to build the resilience of our community and aims to sensitise, train and mobilise the community during emergencies. SGSecure focuses on **three** core actions that every one of us can do during emergencies:

- Staying Alert (Vigilance) to prevent and to keep your family, friends and yourself safe in the event of a emergency.
- •Staying United (<u>Cohesion</u>) through building strong ties in the community; cherishing and safeguarding Singapore's racial and religious diversity and harmony so that we can stand together in peacetime and crisis; and
- Staying Strong (<u>Resilience</u>) by being ready to deal with a crisis, being resilient as individuals and as a community, to help each other bounce back guickly after a emergency.

4. Parent-Teacher Conference (PTC)/Parent-Child-Teacher Conference (PCTC) on Thursday, 25 May and Friday, 26 May

Parent-Teacher Conference (PTC) for Primary 3 to 6 students:

Primary 3 to 6 students need not report to school on these two days. Instead, they will be assigned work on Student Learning Space (SLS) to be completed at home.

Parent-Child-Teacher Conference (PCTC) for Primary 1 to 2 students:

Primary 1 to 2 students need not report to school on these two days. However, to facilitate the PCTC, parents are to bring your child/ward along during your selected time slot. Work on Student Learning Space (SLS) will also be assigned for all Primary 1 to 2 students to be completed at home.

All appointment bookings are open and will close on 5 May via Parent Gateway (PG). Appointments are booked on a first-come-first-serve basis. Your punctuality and adherence to the time slot selected by you will be greatly appreciated. You may email your child's/ward's Class Mentors and Subject teachers to make alternative arrangements if all booking slots are taken up.

5. June Holidays from Monday, 29 May to Friday, 23 June

The school holidays will begin from Monday, 29 May to Friday, 23 June. The new school semester begins on Monday, 26 June for all students.

6. Travel Declaration for June Holidays

You are required to make a travel declaration if you have plans for your child/ward to travel during the June holidays. A separate notification on travel declaration will be sent to you in due time.
