Dear Parents / Guardians (Our Valued Partners-in-Education)

Here are some updates for November 2023.

1. School Holiday – Results Processing Day (06 November 2023, Monday)

The school will be closed on 06 November, Monday for results processing. All students **do not** need to come to school on this day. School resumes on 07 November, Tuesday for all students.

2. Public Holiday – Deepavali (12 November 2023, Sunday)

As Deepavali falls on 12 November, Sunday, 13 November, Monday will be a public holiday. School resumes on 14 November, Tuesday.

3. 'Use-Your-Hands' Campaign (16 November 2023, Thursday)

The 'Use-Your-Hands' Campaign is scheduled on 16 November, Thursday for students to clean up the classrooms in preparation for the next school year and to instill a sense of responsibility in them towards their learning spaces. Students will need to bring their own rags for the cleanup.

4. AIPS Hi-Five Awards Ceremony (16 November 2023, Thursday)

We will be celebrating the achievements of our P1 and P2 students during curriculum hours. Students will be invited up on stage to receive their awards. Awardees will be notified at a later date.

5. AIPS Appreciation Day and Staff Lunch (17 November 2023, Friday)

There is no school on 17 November, Friday as we are celebrating the achievements of our P3 to P6 awardees and staff. Parents will be invited to join the awardee up on stage to receive the award. The invitation letter to the awardee and his/her parents will be sent out at a later date. All P6 students are invited to attend the ceremony as audience. The P6 students will report to school at 7.45am in full school uniform and be dismissed at 10.30am.

6. Travel Declaration for Year-End School Holidays

A notification on Travel Declaration will be sent out via Parents' Gateway for parents/wards to provide travel details if your child/ward is travelling during the year-end school holidays. Please do so by **17 November (Friday)** if your child/ward is travelling overseas.

7. Opening Hours of General Office during November and December School Holidays

The operating hours for the General Office during the November and December school holidays is 8.00am-5.00pm, Monday to Friday. Students should don their school uniform and school shoes as long as they are in school, including school holidays. Please remind your child/ward to do so if he/she is coming to school during the school holidays.

8. Commencement of New School Term in 2024 (02 January 2024, Tuesday)

The P1 students will report to school on 02 January, Tuesday while P2-P6 students will only report on 03 January, Wednesday. Please take note of a change in reporting time with effect from 2024. All students are to report to school at **7.30am**, in their school uniform. They will be considered as late-comers if they arrive after 7.30am.



9. School Hours for All Levels in 2024

The school hours for all levels in 2024 will be from 7.30am to 1.30pm on all days.


10. Security Measures for Visitors

All visitors are required to report to the Security Guard Post to perform the necessary registration, and to obtain a Visitor's Pass before proceeding to the General Office. Please display the pass visibly at all times as unauthorized personnel in the school premise will be asked to leave immediately.
